Audience

- School-level leadership teams seeking to build common ground around the Wisconsin vision for Rtl

Objectives

During this session, school-level leadership teams will experience:

- Rationale to embrace and school readiness to implement the Wisconsin Rtl (W-Rtl) Framework
- Take away activities to support staff buy-in, understanding, and implementation of the W-Rtl Framework
- A completed baseline assessment using the Wisconsin Rtl School-wide Implementation Review
- A determination of a narrowed priority to aid in action planning

- School-level trend data (WKCE, grades, screening data, graduation rates, etc.)
